










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The campaign

The Hepatitis B Chinese Campaign aims to promote hepatitis B prevention strategies and reduce stigma among the Chinese population in NSW.

Studies suggest that there is a high prevalence of hepatitis B virus (HBV) in people born overseas (1.9%) compared to the people born in Australia (0.4%).

We developed this toolkit to support health professionals and community organisations in raising awareness and promoting hepatitis B testing, vaccination, treatment and care among Chinese communities.

Background

This campaign, a collaborative effort with the Chinese communities, was co-designed from 2023 to 2024 in the South Eastern Sydney Local Health District (SESLHD).

ASHM's *Viral Hepatitis Mapping Project* showed almost 45% of people living with chronic hepatitis B were from Chinese backgrounds in 2020 in SESLHD.[1] This higher prevalence may be attributed to the high prevalence of hepatitis B in China, as well as limited awareness, vaccination, testing, stigma, and barriers to accessing healthcare services.

This campaign was co-designed with Chinese communities and is a collaboration between the Sexual Health and Blood Borne Virus Services and the Equity and Prevention Service in SESLHD, Advance Diversity Services, Central and Eastern Sydney Primary Health Network, Chinese Australian Service Society, Hepatitis NSW, NSW Multicultural HIV and Hepatitis Service, and St George Hospital Liver Clinic.






