

- NSW recorded 207 new locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night.
- We are still seeing a large number of people who are infectious in the community and this is leading to large transmission rates in workplaces and homes.
- Workplaces of particular concern are freight companies and food handling, such as meatworks.
- Younger adults in their 20s, 30s and 40s who are out and about in the community are getting the virus, and spreading the virus.
- Childcare centres are becoming new venues of concern. Please only send your children to childcare if it is absolutely necessary.
- We need to make August the month that we all get vaccinated.
- We can't live with the delta strain without having a large percentage of the population vaccinated.
- Anyone aged 18 years or over should book an appointment to get vaccinated with any vaccine available to them as soon as possible.
