

- NSW has now reached 88.5% single dose and 67.5% double dose vaccinations.
- Thank you to everyone who has come forward to get vaccinated. We have now administered more than 10.4 million doses in NSW.
- There were 608 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Sadly, seven people have died.
- Please make sure you know the restrictions in your area <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/rules>
- No matter where you are in NSW, it is important that you come forward for testing even with the most minor of symptoms. The sooner we find cases of COVID, the sooner we can stop it spreading in the community.
- Areas with the highest cases are Casula, Liverpool, Bankstown, Punchbowl, Ashcroft, Minto, Granville, Guildford and Jindabyne.
- We are seeing a decline in numbers over the last few days, but we are also seeing a decline in testing. We must remain vigilant so that we don't miss any cases.
- Thank you to everyone for coming forward to be vaccinated – you are helping to keep us all safe.
