

- NSW recorded 1,480 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Sadly 9 people have died.
- We have now reached another important vaccination target. NSW has reached 75% first dose vaccination rate. 42% are fully vaccinated. This gives us more confidence that we will reach our 70% fully vaccinated target by mid-October.
- We want to make sure people are protected around NSW. Book your vaccination today and your second dose as soon as possible at nsw.gov.au
- There has been sewage detection in Bonny Hills with no known cases. Please be vigilant.
- We remain concerned about previously mentioned suburbs in West and Southwest Sydney. Thank you to the residents of the local government areas of concern. We are calling on people from Liverpool and Parramatta to come forward for testing and to get vaccinated.
- We are also concerned about case numbers in Glebe, Waterloo, Redfern and Marrickville. Please come forward for vaccination and look out for symptoms. Come forward for testing even with mild symptoms.
- We have seen a higher rate of spread with Delta, but the majority of children have not had symptoms or have had only mild symptoms. We've seen extremely few children admitted to ICU.
- We know that families and children have been having a hard time, but there is a light at the end of the tunnel being delivered through COVID-safe practices.
