

- NSW recorded 1,127 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Sadly two people have died.
- NSW has now administered over 8.2 million vaccinations. 78.8% of people over 16 have received one dose, 46.5% are fully vaccinated. These are great numbers. Please encourage your friends and family and book your vaccination today at nsw.gov.au
- There has been sewage detection in Young (Murrumbidgee LHD) with no known cases. Please be vigilant.
- Cases continue to be mostly in West and Southwest Sydney. Sydney suburbs of most concern are Auburn, Greenacre, Bankstown, Liverpool, Merrylands, Punchbowl, Riverwood, Yagoona, Condell Park and St Clair. Please make sure you stick to the COVID restrictions.
- We urge anyone with even mild symptoms to come forward for testing.
- New restrictions have been introduced in Yass today to protect the community. Stay at home orders apply for two weeks. Please make sure you know the restrictions in your area <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/rules>
- Cases haven't been increasing as fast as they have been, but we still need to be careful.
- Vaccination is key for us to get out of this outbreak and we are working closely with many organisations to reach vulnerable people. No one will be left behind.
