

- Thank you to everyone who has come forward to get vaccinated. 92.1% of people over 16 have received a first dose, and 80.8% have received both doses. 74.8% of 12-15 year olds have received one dose and around 35.3% are now fully vaccinated.
- There were 273 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 reported in NSW in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Sadly, four people have died.
- Thank you for continuing to come forward for testing – if you have any COVID-19 symptoms it is very important that you get tested, even if you are fully vaccinated.
- Please help your loved ones to make a vaccination booking today
- As students return to school, if they are vaccinated this provides another layer of protection. If your children is aged 12 or more, please think about getting them vaccinated.
- People who do not have strong immune systems or are taking medicine that suppresses their immune systems may need a third dose of vaccine. Please speak to your doctor or pharmacist about what is right for you.
- Please remain vigilant for symptoms wherever you are in the state. We are still seeing cases increase in regional areas such as Hunter New England, Lake Macquarie and Wollongong.
