

- Across NSW, there have now been more than 11.88 million vaccines administered! 92.7% of people over 16 have received a first dose, and 83% are fully vaccinated.
- 76.6% of 12-15 year olds have received one dose and 43.5% are now fully vaccinated.
- There were 345 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 reported in NSW in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Sadly, five people have died.
- Thank you to everyone in the community for getting vaccinated. Vaccination is our best protection against COVID-19, and most people currently being treated for COVID-19 in intensive care units have not been vaccinated.
- If you haven't yet received your COVID-19 vaccination, please come forward. It has never been easier to access a vaccine.
- Please continue to isolate and come forward for testing if you have any symptoms or are a close or casual contact of a person with COVID-19. This is crucial, even if you are fully vaccinated.
- We are concerned about sewage detection in areas with no known cases, including Leeton, Moree, Guyra, Quirindi, Old Bar, Harrington and Boorowa. Everyone in these areas is strongly urged to monitor for the onset of symptoms.
- Until 1 November, people entering NSW from Victoria will need to complete a declaration and adhere to stay at home rules for 14 days. From 1 November, an unvaccinated person who has been in Victoria in the previous 14 days will not be able to enter NSW for a holiday or recreation.
- This weekend there are more than 40 walk-in vaccination clinics for 12-15 year old across the state.
