

- NSW has now reached 83% single dose and 54.2% double dose vaccination. This is outstanding.
- More than 9 million vaccinations have now been given in NSW and 25% of 12-15 year olds have already received a vaccination. There are AstraZeneca, Pfizer and Moderna vaccines available near you – book yours today at [nsw.gov.au](https://www.nsw.gov.au)
- There were 1,035 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Sadly, five people have died.
- There has been a high level of sewage detection in Oberon. Please come forward and get tested even for minor symptoms to make sure we don't miss any undiagnosed cases. We are also seeing increasing cases in the Illawarra region. Pleasingly no new cases have been reported in northern NSW.
- If you have been vaccinated, you will be able to access your vaccination certificate via the Service NSW app in late October. Before then you can access it through the Medicare App or with a copy of your immunisation record from your GP.
- We are doing incredibly well, but we must stay with the program and not become complacent. Please make sure you know the restrictions in your area <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/rules>
