

- NSW recorded 818 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Sadly, three people in their 80s have died overnight.
- Thank you to everyone who has come forward to be vaccinated: A record 738,000 people were vaccinated last week. We have now reached 5.9 million vaccinations. Both AstraZeneca and Pfizer are great vaccinations. If you haven't had yours yet, please book in urgently at nsw.gov.au
- When we reach 70% and 80% vaccination rates we can start to live life more freely. NSW is doing very well with the vaccine rollout and it's possible that we will beat our targets. We are all in this together and we have a plan to get through this.
- If you are aged 16-39 and live in one of the suburbs of concern, you are being prioritised. Please visit [Priority COVID-19 vaccination booking for 16 to 39 year-olds | NSW Government](#) to book
- Greater Western Sydney and Southwest Sydney still have the most cases. Suburbs of most concern are Merrylands, Guildford, Auburn, Greystanes, Greenacre, Bankstown, Blacktown and the surrounding suburbs. Make sure you know the [lockdown rules](#) in your area.
- There were around 160,000 tests yesterday. Please continue to come forward for testing if you have even mild symptoms or are a contact of a case.
