

- NSW has now reached 83.6% single dose and 55.5% double dose vaccination. This is a remarkable. 28% of 12-15 year olds have already received a vaccination.

- There were 1,063 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Very sadly six more people have died.

- It is pleasing to see declining numbers in Western and Southwestern Sydney. Thank you to the LGAs of concern for following health advice and getting vaccinated.

 - Restrictions in the Hilltops region will be extended for another week.
