

- NSW has now reached 85.7% single dose and 60.5% double dose vaccinations. Thank you to the community.
- There were 863 locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night. Tragically another seven people have died.

- We are very pleased to announce that breast screening services are now returning to NSW.
- The Byron and Tweed shire areas will come out of lockdown at midnight tonight.

- NSW Health is looking very closely at Port Macquarie, Kempsey and Muswellbrook due to increasing local cases. We urge residents to be very cautious.
- We have seen great improvements in South and Southwest Sydney, but still Auburn, Punchbowl, Greenacre, Guildford, Bankstown, Penrith, Merrylands and Blacktown continue to be suburbs of concern. We also encourage residents of Wellington to be vigilant for symptoms.
