

- NSW recorded 199 new locally acquired cases of COVID-19 in the 24 hours to 8pm last night.
- Of these locally acquired cases, 88 are linked to a known case or cluster – 67 are household contacts and 21 are close contacts – and the source of infection for 111 cases is under investigation.
- At least 50 cases were infectious in the community.
- We are reminding community that they should not visit other people's houses, or have visitors to your house. This includes your family that don't normally live with you.
- Please don't go into the eight affected LGAs for shopping if you can avoid it, this will help minimise the risk of transmission to neighbouring LGAs.
- Of the 53 people in ICU, 43 have not had a vaccination and none have had two doses of either vaccine.
- Vaccination provides over 90% protection against serious illness and death.
- We need to make August the month that everyone in NSW gets vaccinated!
