Get involved in your health care

• Do you understand what your doctor tells you?

You have a right to request an interpreter and to receive information about your health care in your language.

Do you know what you have agreed to?

You have a right to ask questions about your operation or procedure before giving your consent for treatment.

• Do you know your treatment and options?

You have a right to be fully informed about the services, treatment options and costs.

• Do you ask questions about your health care?

You have a right to comment on your health care and ask questions. It is important to let the hospital/service know when things are going well or badly.

• **Do you tell your doctor and pharmacist about your medication?** You have a responsibility to tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription, over-the-counter and traditional medicines.
